

PENCAITLAND PARISH CHURCH

Location

Located at the heart of the village of Pencaitland (EH34 5DL), the Carriage House is set-back from the main road (A6093) and positioned between the Church and the Primary School, shown between Tyne Water and The Glebe on the satellite image, below.

Tip: Hold down the Ctrl key and roll the wheel on your mouse up to increase the size of the image.



Community Venue

The Carriage House serves as a community venue for the village of Pencaitland and is used by a number of groups throughout the week – from National Childcare Trust, to Scottish Country Dancing.

Facilities for Hire

The Carriage House, owned by Pencaitland Parish Church, is available for lettings. Its



facilities (pictured on the right, top to bottom) are the Groom's Room (9×6 metres); the Carriage Room (7×5 metres); the Apple Loft (9.3×4.3 metres) and the Hay Loft (9×5 metres), which means it can comfortably accommodate groups of between 30 to 60 people, theatre style. Upstairs rooms are carpeted and downstairs rooms are maple floored and have doors that give access to the courtyard—ideal in

sunny weather. The venue has a Kitchen, four toilets, a shower room and parking for around 15 cars although there is also on street parking nearby.
